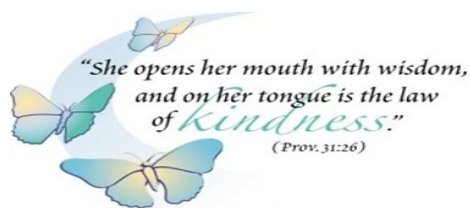
Family-friendly service
